LAKE ILLAWARRA ENTRANCE WORKS STAGE 2 NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN TRAINING WALLS AND CHANNEL DREDGING

PUBLIC "OPEN HOUSE"



The Lake Illawarra Authority has completed the design for proposed work at the entrance to Lake Illawarra.

The work involves the:

- construction of a northern training wall / breakwater off Perkins Beach
- extension of the southern training wall / breakwater off Perkins Beach
- dredging of sections of the entrance channel
- sand nourishment of Warilla Beach and
- extension of the groyne at Little Lake

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the project has been completed and is currently on exhibition.

An Open House to explain the design and EIS process will be held on Saturday 12 February 2005, from 9am to 3pm, at the entry to Windang Foreshore Park, Fern St, Windang NSW 2528. Members of the public are welcome to attend the Open House and view the design and EIS.

Members of the design team and consultant preparing the EIS will be present on the day.
